Rules for the use of the municipal fairground

Section - mobile home/caravan pitch

Issued: 15 July 2020

§ 1

User group

The fairground in Herrieden is a municipal facility. It is available for use by tourists with mobile homes. A mobile home is a vehicle in which one can live, the main focus of use is however travel. Caravans are also admitted if sufficient space is available and these rules for use are complied with. A caravan (also trailer) is a vehicle trailer without a motor of its own which is furnished for living purposes.

Mobile homes and caravans without a permanent road license are not permitted.

Persons without a fixed place of abode are not admitted.

§ 2

Fees

For the municipal fairground, the town of Herrieden charges usage fees and consumption charges in accordance with the attached "Usage fees and consumption charges for the fairground of the town of Herrieden" (appendix).

Consumption charges are incurred for all those users named in § 1 who park their vehicle on the fairground for longer than three days.

§ 3 Length of stay

The permitted length of stay without registration may not exceed 3 days or 2 overnight stays. Longer periods of stay must be registered with the public order office (Ordnungsamt) at Herrnhof 10 no later than the next working day after arrival in Herrieden. The maximum length of stay is 18 days per visit and no more than 30 days per calendar year. There is no entitlement to extend the period of stay. Vehicles or trailers that are parked without permission will be removed at the expense of the owner.

§ 4 Pitches

The fairground is open the whole year. On special occasions (e.g. Kirchweih (fair)), the fairground can be temporarily closed off by the town administration with advance warning. This does not give rise to any claims for compensation against the town of Herrieden.

Users staying for longer than three days can only use the designated places.

The grounds are to be used by the users with due care. It is their responsibility to ensure that the facility is kept in perfect condition both in appearance and technically. The public order office of Herrieden must be informed immediately of any damage or soilage.

The road traffic regulations apply on the fairground.

The town administration does not clear snow from the fairground or spread grit/salt in winter.

§ 5 Day of arrival/departure

Arrivals are possible on any day. For persons staying on the fairground for longer than three days, departure is only possible from Tuesday to Thursday. Departure must be announced to the public order office at least one day before.

§ 6

Utilities and waste disposal

Waste is to be disposed of in accordance with § 8 below. The disposal of waste water and waste on the town property or in the Altmühl river is forbidden. The fairground is to be left in a clean condition.

For users who are not staying longer than three days, pay stations are available for electricity (3 power columns with a total of 12 connections for ordinary 3-pin CEE plugs, 16 A, 230 V).

For stays of more than three days, fresh water and electricity is provided via the auxiliary building. The activation is organised by the public order office. Electricity and water are charged based on consumption. The use of electricity generators with combustion engines is not permitted.

Toilets are not available on the fairground. The public toilet next to the town hall at Herrnhof 10 can be used. It is forbidden to go to the toilet outdoors. The “emptying” of chemical toilets “in the wild” is also forbidden. The emptying station is located at the service station Autohof on the Herrrieden slip road.

The municipal facilities and access to them (skater park and half-pipe) may not be blocked by parked vehicles or in any other way.

It is not permitted to wash vehicles.

§ 7

Cleaning

The fairground must be left in a clean and tidy condition.

There are two ways of disposing of waste:

- a. Residual waste sacks can be purchased in the town hall (currently for a price of EUR 4 per sack). These are left behind on the fairground in one place after departure and disposed of by the town of Herrrieden.
- b. The user requests a container from a waste disposal company. The container is collected and returned by the user at their own expense.

§ 8 User fee

A fee has to be paid for the use of every pitch. The fee is EUR 10.00 per mobile home or caravan and day (24h). The requirement to pay the fee arises when the vehicle is first parked on the fairground. The pitch fee and the charge for the supply of fresh water and electricity based on the volume used must be paid at the public order office of the town of Herrrieden at Herrnhof 10 on the day of departure.

§ 9 Dogs

Dogs are in principle allowed on the fairground. Dog excrement must be disposed of in the residual waste containers. In the town, dogs must be kept on the lead. Outside the town, dogs may only be let off the lead if they are accompanied by a person and they follow voice commands issued by that person.

§ 10 Peace at night

The nearby residents and other guests to the fairground should be treated with due consideration. Peace at night must be maintained between 10 pm and 6 am. In this time, all activities that cause noise which disturbs the peace at night are forbidden.

§ 11 Open fires

Open fires are not permitted. Cooking and barbecuing is only allowed with a licensed electric or gas device.

§ 12 Liability

Use of the fairground is at the user's own risk. The town is not liable for any damage which is caused by the use of the pitch, its supply and disposal facilities or by the elements, force majeure or third parties.

The users are liable for all culpable damage, i.e. caused by wilful or negligent action as a result of their not following the rules of use.

§ 13 House rules

The fairground is the property of the town of Herrieden and is subject to its oversight. Employees of the town of Herrieden are responsible for looking after it. These employees are the contact persons for questions relating to the general care of the fairground. The instructions of these employees, enforcement agents of the town and other authorised persons must be followed.

Vehicles or trailers that are parked without permission will be removed at the expense of the owner.

If these rules of use are contravened, the persons responsible for the fairground can expel or ban these persons from the fairground.

§ 14 Amendments and ancillary covenants

Ancillary covenants and amendments to the present agreement must be made in writing in order to be effective.

§ 15

Exceptions

In isolated instances, the mayor can allow exceptions from the rules of use for good reason.

§ 16

Effective date

This regulation shall enter into force on 1 August 2020. It is in force until further notice.

Appendix:

Usage fees and consumption charges for the fairground of the town of Herrieden

The use of the fairground, section - mobile home/caravan pitch, is free of charge for users who stay for no more than three days or two nights.

Above and beyond this, the following costs are incurred:

Deposit: EUR 600.00
(Payable on the day of registration in the public order office)

Pitch fee: EUR 10.00/ per mobile home or caravan and day (24h)
(The day of arrival and departure count as one day)

Electricity: EUR 0.50/kWh (incl. the valid VAT)
Water: EUR 2.00/cbm (incl. the valid VAT)
